Organization of OPCT 2023

- First inviting the current members of the IFIP WG 1.8.
- Then inviting further concurrency theory researchers.
- Total of 118 invitees (89 males, 29 females):
 - 48 participating as speakers (37+11).
 - 12 willing to give a talk but unable to come in the end (4+8).
 - **43** declined our invitation (35+8).
 - **15** did not respond (13+2).
